

The NLSST is coordinated in part by the American College of Radiology Imaging Network (ACRIN) a national cancer research organization funded by the National Cancer Institute (NCI). ACRIN is comprised of investigators at over 100 leading medical facilities in North America and abroad.

The National Lung Screening Trial (NLSST) will help to answer the most important questions about the benefits of lung cancer screening. To date, no screening test has been shown to lower the number of lung cancer deaths. Without the participation of NLSST volunteers, new knowledge about lung cancer screening would not be possible.
